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Vsebina predmeta zajema naslednje teme:

1) zgodovinska konstrukcija ženskega in moškega telesa, spolnosti in čustvovanja v kritični in primerjalni perspektivi;

- ženske in norost v zgodovinski in primerjalni perspektivi,

- hendikep in deviantno telo iz perspektive spola;

- reproduktivne pravice žensk v mednarodni perspektivi;

2) dejavniki tveganja in zaščite za razvoj duševnih stisk,

- vpliv revščine in globalnih neenakosti na duševno zdravje ljudi in na razvoj hendikepa,

- vpliv nasilja na ženske in na konstrukcijo hendikepa,

- medikalizacija in vpliv farmakološke industrije na življenje žensk,

- tihe odvisnosti žensk;

3) reproduktivne tehnologije v globalni perspektivi in etične dileme;

4) zdravje in hendikep v luči družbenih neenakosti v globalni perspektivi;

5) razvoj politik in služb za področje hendikepa in duševnega zdravja občutljivih na spol,

- upoštevanje spola v intervencijah socialnega dela,

- dobre prakse v socialnem varstvu na področju duševnega zdravja in hendikepa.

The content of the module:

1) The historical construction of the women's and men's bodies, sexuality and emotions through a historical and comparative perspective;

- Women and madness in a historical perspective;

- Disabled and the deviant body from a gender perspective;

- Reproductive rights of women in international perspective;

2) The risk factors for the development of mental ill problems and the factors of protection;

- The impact of poverty and global inequalities on health and other disabilities;

- The influence of violence on women's lives and on the development of disabilities;

- The medicalization and the impact of the pharmaceutical industry on women's lives;

- The »silent« dependencies; .

3) Reproductive technologies in a global perspectives and some ethical dilemmas;

4) Health and disability from the perspective of social inequalities in a global perspective;

5) The development of policies and services in the areas of mental health and disability from a gender perspective;

- Understanding gender during social work interventions;

- Good practices in social welfare in the areas of mental health and disabilities.

Objectives and competences:

Competencies and skills for the needs analysis and planning of services in specific areas of health, public health and in the social area.

The understanding of institutions in the area of health and social issues and the development of public health with greater emphasis on social understandings of the determinants of health and the production of disabilities.

Predvideni študijski rezultati:
